From Moor Pool Hall to corner of Circle and Moorpool Avenue

• Arts and Crafts planning, landscaping, and architecture

Up Northgate and take path off to allotments

• Pathway network; Planned Open Spaces between houses

Pathway through to Park Edge

• Planting for "Moor Pool in Bloom"

Listed Flats, one of two sets on Ravenhurst Road

• Special architectural features

Along Margaret Grove

• Curvilinear road design; Architectural features; site of first Bowling Green

Junction of Moorpool Avenue and Park Hill Road

• First House on the estate; site of "first" Sod-cutting

Up Moorpool Avenue – tennis courts on right. Cross Ravenhurst Road towards path by Pool and Bowling Green

• *Listed flats*(2) (and entrance to 'site A')

Along Pool and Bowling Green path.

• Resident heron? moor-hens? ducks definitely

Drop off at Bowling Green if wish (open today), or continue and turn up path on left to Moorpool Avenue and the Hall.
